Moving Forward in 2024

A part of me has always dreaded January 1. A new year begins and it takes me a few weeks before I start writing that new year on my checks. The month of January is always cold and seems like the longest month of the year. So, to help get me excited about a new year, I always take time to glance back before focusing forward.

- Continued development of ministries such as family ministries (children, youth, and young adults), BOLD, and outreach and service ministries

- Restoration of fellowship times like game nights (Dutch Blitz, Dominoes, etc.) and old-fashioned potluck meals.
- Continued development of small group Bible studies including an adult bible study every Wednesday night

- Renewed commitment to community and pastoral care through staff and deacons
- Five baptized believers and eight new members
- Adoption of a five-year strategic vision which will enable us to grow deeper and branch out

We are moving forward in 2024 to improve our Sunday morning experience, develop our family ministry and start new small groups, and make the necessary building modifications to provide for growth in these areas and keep us safe each time we are together. We will journey through Lent focusing on Jesus in the Gospel of John as we move toward March 31, Resurrection Sunday. We will continue to serve one another (one of the sermons coming in January!) and our community with grace and compassion—just like Jesus! And most of all we will continue preaching and teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ through all our ministries. We are moving forward with great expectation that the best of Mechanic Grove Church of the Brethren is yet to come.

World Missions Opportunity

Bob Kettering has reached out to ask for help in supporting an upcoming mission project. The Venezuelan Church of the Brethren Annual Conference will be held in Columbia March 13-18, 2024. Part of this Conference will include pastoral training in Brethren beliefs, history and practices. They have invited Joel Pena from Alpha and Omega; Leonor Ochoa from Ebenezer COB and Bob Kettering to be the teachers. Those who are organizing this effort are asking for \$10,000 to support transporting their pastors, lodging and meals.

Mechanic Grove has the opportunity to support this mission project. Donations to support this effort can be placed in the offering plate marked "Venezuelan Annual Conference" and are needed by the end of January.

Special Offerings

Have you ever wondered about our Special Offerings that occur the first through fourth Sundays of the month and what they do? Hopefully this will help...

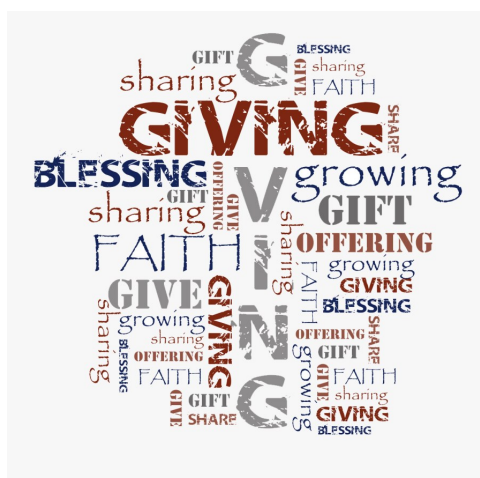
First Sunday ~ "Change for Change" is a movement for change. By bringing in your pocket change or other change you've found, big changes can be made in the world. This offering is divided equally between Brethren Housing Association (BHA) and Brethren World Missions.

Second Sunday ~ "2¢ a Meal Offering" reminds us of the poor and less fortunate at mealtime. It encourages us to engage in a daily devotional exercise of giving at least two cents per person per meal as we give thanks for our own food. Many people feel led to give more. Money collected is given to the Global Food Initiative through the Church of the Brethren.

Third Sunday ~ "Mealbarrow Sunday" is set aside to bring items for our local food bank to benefit those in need in our community. Items may be placed in the "mealbarrow" located at the end of the coat rack by the elevator. A list of needed items is printed in the bulletin.

Fourth Sunday ~ "Birthday Offering" is given by those celebrating their birthday month. The money collected goes into the Benevolence Fund which is used to help those in our MGCB family or community with groceries, gas or other expenses. The funds are overseen by the Pastor/Professional Staff, Deacon Chairs and the treasurer.

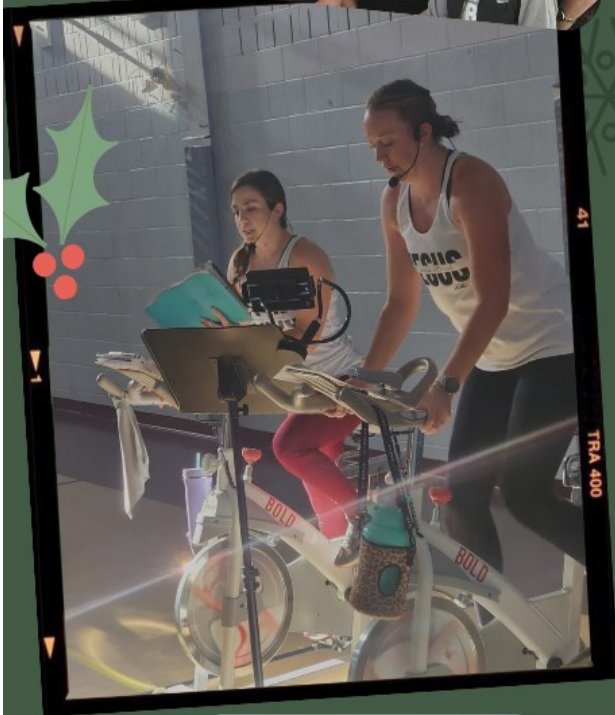
